



## **Book Club Options**

1. Students will post to the discussion board a response to my initial posting by Wednesday. This can be done at home or in the classroom. I will respond to students and encourage an online discussion. These discussions will be printed and emailed to the teacher on Sunday.
2. I will post a thought provoking question for your book on Sunday evening. You can discuss with your students and have them post a collective response by Wednesday. This will allow classes that are reading the same book to interact with one another. I will also add to the discussion.
3. A mix of both. You can choose to combine options one and two in any way that works for you and your students.

### **Enrolling in the online book club:**

1. Go to the Shelby County Website:

2. Click on the discussion link for your grade level.
3. You will be asked to sign in with your Google account. If you do not have one, you can create one here.
4. You may also choose to have each student create a Gmail account. I would recommend getting parent permission before allowing your students to sign up for an account. I have a parent form that you may use if you are interested.
5. Once you have logged in, you will be asked to apply for membership. I will be sent a request to allow you access to the book club. This is to ensure that our book club only includes Shelby County members.
