

Let's create a quiz!

1. <http://www.wordsmyth.net/>
2. Click on the **quiz makers** drop down menu.
3. Choose **multiple choice**. This is the screen that will appear.

Multiple Choice Quiz Maker

This tool is limited to 15 words. Please register to increase this limit to 25 words. Also registered user can save tools results as public URL.

1. Choose a dictionary to use for your quiz.

- Advanced Children's Beginner's

2. Type the words for your quiz in the space below. Separate each keyword with a space. To list two words together, contain them in quotation marks (example: "test tube"). Limit 15 words.

3. Multiple Choice Quiz Title (optional):

Include the date with your title?

This label will appear as the "title" of your Multiple Choice Quiz.

4. Choose data mode for your Multiple Choice Quiz:

4. Choose **children's** for the dictionary type.
5. Type your words in the box. You can only enter 15 at a time, unless you register. It is FREE to register and it allows you to enter 25 words at a time. Either way, you will need to make **2** quizzes.
6. Name your quiz. This will make it easier to keep track of all the quizzes you make.
7. Choose **definition** for the data mode.
8. Click **next**.
9. The next screen allows you to make further choices.

Customize Your Multiple Choice Quiz

This tool is limited to 15 words. Please register to increase this limit to 25 words. Also registered user can save tools results as public URL.

These words are included: **cat, dog, horse**

- a. Choose the definitions for your Multiple Choice Quiz.
- b. Click "customize" if you want to change or annotate definition.

- select 1st definition for each word
- select 1st definition for each part of speech
- select all definitions
- select which definitions to use

You can choose to allow the computer to choose which definitions to use **or** you can choose.

10. Click **next**.
11. At this point, you can continue customizing the quiz or just leave it as it reads. I would read through it and make sure that nothing jumps out as you as incorrect.
12. Click **next**.
13. You now have now created a quiz! 😊
14. Choose **save**.
15. You are ready to print and give to your students.
